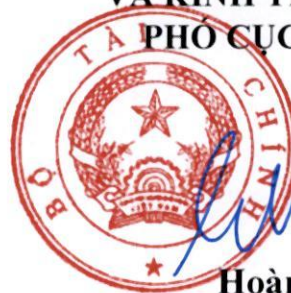

Accommodation: Participants will be accommodated at a hotel / alternative accommodation within the vicinity of the training institute. Participants are **strictly not allowed** to bring any family members under the award of MTCP programmes

Daily Allowance: Participants will be provided with daily allowance.

Meals: Meals will be provided throughout the duration of the course.

Air fares: A return economy class flight ticket from the capital city of the recipient country to Kuala Lumpur is provided for participants.

Course Fees: All course fees are borne by the Government of Malaysia.

Dress Code: Participants are required to dress in formal or office attire throughout the class sessions as well as during official visits to Government Ministries / Agencies

APPLICATION AND ENQUIRIES

Only complete applications that are made through the MTCP website at <https://mtcp.kln.gov.my/courses2/list2> will be considered. Select the course name and click "Apply Course" to generate a new application form.

Applicants are required to complete the online application form, upload a passport sized photo, and provide a self-introduction video. A draft link will be sent via email and must be accessed using a One-Time Password (OTP) and submitted with seven (7) days. The manual for the application process can be found on the MTCP Website.

All application forms must be duly completed and endorsed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of candidates' respective countries and should be submitted only through the diplomatic channel via Malaysian Embassy/ High Commission of Malaysia.

Successful candidates will be duly notified by AMSAS one (1) month before the commencement of the course.

Incomplete and/or unendorsed forms will not be considered

VISA AND VACCINATION

For countries that requires visa to enter Malaysia, you must apply for eVISA before departing.

- Upload the necessary travel documents through the system.
- Ensure that all documents scanned clearly for the smooth process of approval.
- eVISA fees and related costs are to be borne by the participants.

- Bring along the eVISA and all the necessary travel documents for the arrival in Malaysia.

For countries that do not require visa to enter Malaysia, may enter with Social Visit Pass.

THE MALAYSIAN TECHNICAL COOPERATION PROGRAMME

The Malaysian Technical Cooperation Programme (MTCP) was initiated at the First Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting (CHOGM) for Asia Pacific Region held in Sydney in February 1978. It was officially launched on 7th September 1980 at the 2nd CHOGM in New Delhi, India to signify Malaysia's commitment to South-South Cooperation, in particular Technical Cooperation among Developing Countries (TCDC).

The MTCP is conducted through the sharing of Malaysia's development experiences and by providing training and technical advices in key areas that are important for the development of a country. Since its conception, technical and capacity-building programmes under the MTCP have benefited more than 40,000 participants from participating countries.

SULTAN AHMAD SHAH MARITIME ACADEMY (AMSAS)

AMSAS was established to carry out the agency's functions in line with the provisions of the law as stated in Part III Section 6 (1) (g) of the Malaysian Maritime Enforcement Agency (MMEA) Act 2004 (Act 633) which is establishing and managing maritime institutions for the training of MMEA Officers. Formerly known as PPL APMM, AMSAS has been training MMEA staff since April 2005, in a residential building block for trainees temporarily loaned by the Royal Malaysian Navy (TLDM), Lumut. On 24 July 2007, the training institute moved to Bandar Indera Mahkota, Kuantan. AMSAS was then finally shifted from a temporary building in Bandar Indera Mahkota, Kuantan to a well-equipped training centre in Sungai Ular, Gebeng, Pahang on 1 August 2011. The newly built institution is able to accommodate and train more officers due to its strategic location. On 2 March 2013, AMSAS was inaugurated by His Majesty Sultan Haji Ahmad Shah of Pahang. AMSAS is capable of training basic courses for new MMEA staff, as well as accommodating advanced courses including maritime training in the region.
